

SAVE WATER IN THE YARD THIS SUMMER

As temperatures rise in the summer, so does our outdoor water use, mostly on lawns and landscapes.



29 billion gallons of daily household water use across the U.S.

9 billion gallons come from daily residential outdoor water use, mainly for landscape irrigation.



Water use spikes in the summer!

Depending on the region, homeowners use **30-60%** of their water outdoors.



50% of that is wasted, in part, due to overwatering.



Average family's water use:

320 gallons per day



During the summer, can be up to

1,000 gallons per day



Some even use up to

= 100 gallons



—equal to leaving a garden hose running for nearly

8 hours!



Simple Things We Can All Do

•Step on it:

Step on the lawn: if the grass springs back, it doesn't need water.

Leave it long:

Longer grass promotes a more drought-resistant lawn, reduced evaporation, and fewer weeds.

Take a sprinkler break:

Grass isn't really meant to be bright green in the summer.

Meet & Greet

The Kelsey Bass Museum had the honor of hosting book signing events by two very distinct authors. It was a standing room only event, on June21, 2023. That day the Kelsey Bass Museum, in conjunction with the Starr County Historical Commission, hosted Stephen Michaud, author or Robert's Story-the TRUE story of a Texas cowboy's troubled life and horrifying death. 


